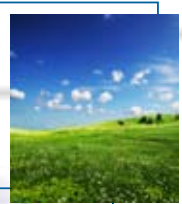

## Environmental Permitting Regulations

**The Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) Directive was implemented in England and Wales in 2000 through the Pollution Prevention and Control Regulations 2000, these have since been replaced by the Environmental Permitting Regulations 2007.**

**What experience has been gained and what are the future challenges related to these regulations?**

The Environmental Permitting Regulations were enabled in England and Wales in April 2008, replacing the Waste Management Licensing and Pollution Prevention and Control (PPC) permitting systems.

What experience has been gained since the initial implementation of the PPC regulations? How can best practice be shared and how are the new permitting regulations likely to affect industry in the future?
